### WELCOME TO PINE CREST SUMMER!

#### Dates:

Camps are open to the public for grades pre-kindergarten through twelve\* and are offered from June 10 to August 9, 2019. All programs operate Monday through Friday, except for Thursday, July 4.

*\*Programs, ages, grade levels, and dates may vary by campus.*

#### Typical Day:

A camper's typical day consists of engaging morning activities, snack, and lunch; the afternoon follows a similar schedule with more exciting activities and an afternoon snack. Some programs offer pool and arcade time as well. For our academic programs, campers will review academic materials throughout the morning along with a snack and recess.

#### Lunch/Snacks:

A variety of lunch choices, including a salad bar, deli bar, and hot lunches are provided daily. Additionally, all campers receive a morning and an afternoon snack. We realize that campers have varying diets, preferences, and requirements. While we offer a diverse menu, Pine Crest does not accommodate special diets related to allergies. We do not operate a kosher kitchen, and our campuses are not peanut-free.

#### Transportation:

Bus service is available to and from the Fort Lauderdale Campus throughout most of Broward County as well as select stops in North Miami/Aventura and south Boca Raton. Bus service fees start at \$75/week for A.M. or P.M.

#### Discounts:

There will be a 10% discount for attending 8 weeks of Pine Crest Summer. There is also a 5% discount for attending 4 or more weeks. Full payment and enrollment are due by May 1, 2019.

Camp will be closed on July 4. Tuition will be reduced for this week. (\$385, \$425, \$475, or \$510 pending program selection)

## SIGNATURE PROGRAMS

### FAST & FURIOUS RACE CARS

Grades: 2-8 | \$450/wk

Race to win! Design your own race car to compete on a track. Engage in woodworking skills to create the fastest car. The strategy is a must if you want to make the fastest car.

### FORENSICS

Grades: 6-8 | \$450/wk

Through hands-on, experiential learning, participants will investigate topics such as crime scene investigation, evidence recovery and handling, and analysis of fingerprints, forensic DNA, bloodstain patterns, trace evidence, and footwear impressions. Through these investigations, students will use critical thinking skills, advanced technology, and data analysis to examine and interpret the evidence from a mock crime scene.

### GET YOUR COOK ON!

Grades: 2-8 | \$450/wk

Campers will learn basic food skills in a fun and safe environment under the instruction of Chef Nick! Campers will work together measuring, chopping, and stirring to create delicious and healthy recipes. The week will culminate with a catered luncheon for parents created by the campers. Afternoons will include pool and other cooking activities.

### PANTHER CAMPERS

Grades: PK-K | \$450/wk

Our Panther Campers program offers students in pre-kindergarten (must be four years old by their first day of camp) and kindergarten opportunities to explore and learn a variety of indoor and outdoor activities. Campers will participate in physical education activities, including soccer, t-ball, basketball, and movement. Teachers incorporate arts and crafts, puppetry, interactive storytelling, treasure hunts, game room, and more. Campers have an option of enrolling for a full day of Panther Campers or for a half-day with Elevate in the morning and Panther Campers in the afternoon.

## ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

### ELEVATE

Grades: PK-8 | \$585/wk

ELEVATE your academics with theme-based learning. This serves as both a review and extension of grade-level skills based on the needs of the students. This program operates in the morning and is combined with an afternoon selection. Afternoon options include: Panther Campers, Sports, Swim, or Tennis.

### ROBOTICS

Grades: 4-8 | \$500/wk

Are you interested in growing your skills in LEGO® Robotics? Then our intensive robotics camp is the program for you! This camp will focus on LEGO EV3 building and programming using past FIRST LEGO League challenge seasons. Participation in this camp will prepare students for competitive robotics teams!

### STEM

### DIGITAL MEDIA

Grades: 4-8 | \$450/wk

### TENNIS

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### TRADITIONAL DAY CAMP

Grades: K-7 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-8

For 61 fantastic summers, campers and counselors have joined together in a fun and supportive spirit, making summer memories worth reminiscing for years to come. As a traditional summer day camp with activities inside and outside, campers enjoy the campus and the original signature camp at Pine Crest School. This program may be combined with a morning of ELEVATE or Tennis.

### AVIATION YOUNG FLYERS

Grades: 6-8 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-3

Calling all Middle School students who are interested in flying and aviation enthusiasts! Learn what it takes to be a pilot:

- The basic fundamentals of flight with a ground school component
- How air traffic control towers work
- General aviation airports and the different types of airspaces
- Airplanes, simulator, and more
- Includes field trip(s)

### CREATURE FEATURE

Grades: 2-8 | \$450/wk | Wks. 7-8

Campers will work together measuring, chopping, and stirring to create delicious and healthy recipes. The week will culminate with a catered luncheon for parents created by the campers. Afternoons will include pool and other cooking activities.

### GREEN GENES

Grades: 6-8 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-3

Become a DNA scientist! Discover the unique structure and function of DNA and investigate how to understand its universal role as a genetic blueprint using the very tools scientists use to manipulate DNA. Campers will gain knowledge and practice of DNA biotechnology by introducing a fluorescent "green gene" normally found in the jellyfish *Aequorea victoria* into bacterium. Each day's activities are designed as an entry point for the next day's lab work; proficiency in learning and applying laboratory techniques are an essential component of the toolbox that will make you a DNA scientist.

### SPIRIT CAMP

Grades: 2-6 | \$450/wk | Wks. 4 & 8

We've got spirit, yes we do! We've got spirit, now you will too! Campers will learn cheers, chants, and a routine which they'll perform at the end of the week. Campers will also create cool crafts to show their support of others.

## FINE ARTS CAMP

**Grades: K-8 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-3**

Join Pine Crest Fine Arts teachers as we put on a show! Each week at Fine Arts Camp, we will explore art projects, set development, movement, choreography, music making, stage direction, singing, acting, and so much more! A camp show is performed in Week 3.

## MUSICAL PRODUCTION CAMP

**Grades: 2-8 | \$450/wk | Wks. 4-5**

Become a music producer with new, state-of-the-art sound equipment! Learn electronic music techniques, such as producing a record, writing a hit song, creating music for a video, or producing a soundtrack. You will even learn how to DJ your next party!

## SPORTS CAMPS

### BASEBALL

**Grades: 4-9 | \$450/wk | Wks. 6-7**

Using Pine Crest School's batting cages and fields, baseball players will have opportunities to work on arm strength, pitching, field position development, and hitting mechanics to help improve their swing. Pool and Sports Performance\* will be included.

### BASKETBALL

**Grades: 4-9 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-2**

Basketball players in grades four through nine will receive coaching on foundational skills including defense, dribbling and handling, footwork, layup shots, and shooting form. Players will refine basketball skills on the same courts as Pine Crest alumnus Brandon Knight '10 during scrimmages and three on three, full court, half court, and knock out games.

### COMPETITIVE SWIM

**Grades: 3-10 | \$550/wk | Ages 8-16 | Wks. 1-8**

Swimmers will be instructed in all aspects of competitive swimming with a focus on technique in all four strokes, dives, turns, and underwaters as well as a race strategy, nutrition, and mental preparation. All campers will be filmed underwater and analyzed to improve their technique. A typical day includes two swim sessions, one dryland session, and one classroom session.

Led by two-time Olympian and Pine Crest Director of Aquatics Mariusz Podkoscielny, Pine Crest's Competitive Swim Camp is Fort Lauderdale's premiere summer swim camp program. *Note: No longer an overnight camp*

### GIRLS' LACROSSE

**Grades: 4-9 | \$450/wk | Wk. 4**

Lacrosse campers will receive personalized instruction on fundamental stick skills including catching, cradling, scooping, shooting and throwing while participating in drills and scrimmages. Pool and Sports Performance\* will be included.

### RIISING STARS SWIM AND DIVE CAMP

**Grades: K-5 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-8**

Pine Crest's Rising Stars summer swim and dive camp is dedicated to teaching campers the basics of all four strokes, survival techniques, and water safety. The camp day includes swim and dive sessions, games, and activities in and out of the pool. This program may be combined with a morning of ELEVATE or Tennis Camp.

### ROWING

**Grades: 5-9 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-4**

Summer is a great opportunity to try rowing for the first time in a no-pressure, fun, and safe space. For the more seasoned rower, summer is a great time to gain more practical training and technique in preparation for the upcoming fall season. We encourage rising freshmen who are interested in joining crew in the fall to attend camp to prepare for the upcoming season. The Pine Crest coaching staff will train the student-athletes on boat handling skills, the basic rowing stroke, and teamwork. Pool and Sports Performance\* will be included.

### SOCCER

**Grades: 4-9 | \$450/wk | Wk. 5**

Pine Crest soccer campers will work on tactics and fundamentals, including dribbling, passing, receiving, and shots on goal. Warm-ups, drills, and half-field games will be included in soccer camp. Pool and Sports Performance\* will be included.

### TENNIS

**Grades: K-7 | \$450/wk | Wks. 1-3**

Tennis Camp emphasizes learning the sport of tennis in a fun, engaging manner with a focus on gameplay mixed with instruction and tennis fundamentals. Our tennis program is led by Pine Crest's United States Professional Tennis Association (USPTA) Certified Tennis Professionals. With a focus on gameplay mixed with instruction, campers learn tennis fundamentals, including conditioning, footwork, physical fitness, and strokes. ### VOLLEYBALL:
